Powered by over 1,500 solar panels, the site operates on renewable energy, making it one of Britain's most eco-efficient timber manufacturing spaces.

We're also proud to house one of the few Organic Rankine Cycle (ORC) systems in the country — technology that converts our timber offcuts into clean electricity.

This commitment to innovation ensures that every staircase we create is produced responsibly, efficiently, and to the highest standards of accuracy and finish.

Closed String Staircase

A closed string staircase features its treads and risers enclosed between solid side stringers, concealing the stair profile from view. This creates a clean, seamless appearance that feels both timeless and architectural — equally suited to traditional and contemporary homes.

Balusters - also called spindles - are typically slotted directly onto a base rail, producing a refined, understated aesthetic that emphasises simplicity, safety, and structural strength.



Decorative skirting can follow the incline of the stairs, providing a tailored finish where the staircase meets the wall.

The concealed stringers also allow for design flexibility — from classic turned spindles to sleek glass panels — making this a versatile choice that blends elegance with everyday functionality.

Each closed string staircase is crafted to balance form and function, delivering a design that feels solid, refined, and perfectly suited to its setting.

Cut String Staircase

A cut string staircase showcases exposed treads and risers, with outer stringers cut to trace their profile. This traditional design reveals the beauty of the staircase structure and highlights the craftsmanship within.

Often enriched with carved brackets or detailing, it's a hallmark of period homes — especially those from the Georgian and Victorian eras — where proportion and ornamentation were celebrated.



The open side allows turned balusters and finely detailed newel posts to shine, transforming the staircase into a statement feature.

Whether crafted in rich hardwoods or finished in painted timber, the cut string staircase remains a symbol of refined British joinery — timeless, elegant, and characterful.

Double Cut String Staircase

A double cut string staircase exposes the treads and risers on both sides, revealing the stair profile in its entirety. Reserved for grand settings such as entrance halls or double-return flights, this design showcases craftsmanship from every angle.

The symmetry and openness of a double cut string staircase create a sense of light and space, while ornate balustrades, sweeping handrails, and carefully detailed newel posts elevate it to a true architectural centrepiece.



Each bespoke design combines structural precision with aesthetic sophistication, resulting in a staircase that defines its space through proportion, grace, and artistry.

Precision-engineered and hand-finished, it demonstrates how traditional joinery can achieve structural excellence without compromising beauty or scale.

The alternating pattern of open and closed risers creates movement and balance, while bespoke combinations of timber, glass, or metalwork provide endless design possibilities.

Loft Eaves Doors

Typically crafted from timber or MDF, these doors can be hinged or push-to-open, offering a neat, practical solution that maintains the loft's clean aesthetic while enhancing hidden storage potential.

Our entire manufacturing process operates on renewable energy, powered by more than 1,500 solar panels and supported by the UK's first ORC (Organic Rankine Cycle) system, which converts timber waste into clean electricity. Two biomass boilers heat our factory using offcuts from production, ensuring nothing goes to waste.

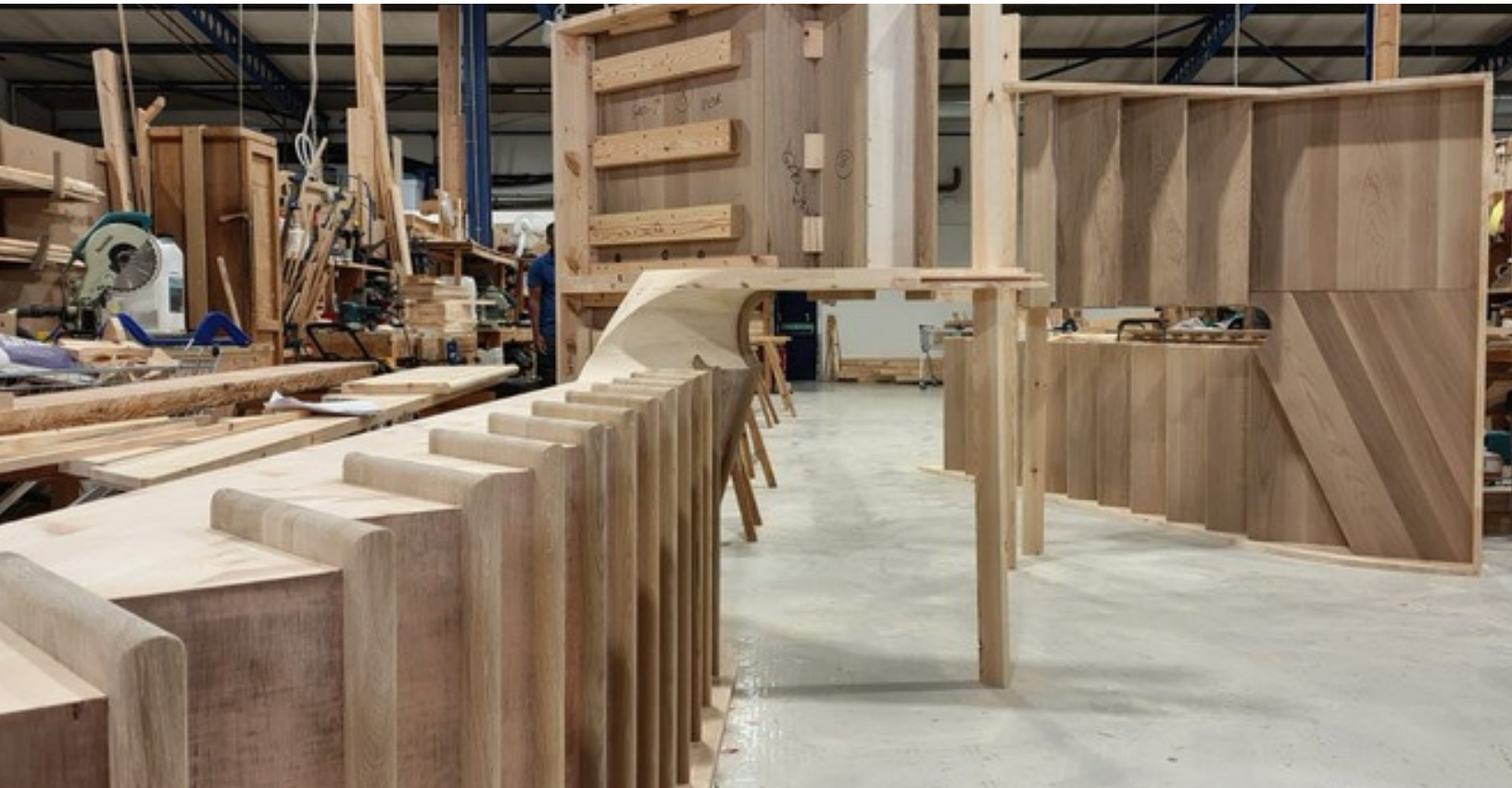
